

## Regulation for pouring beer at the Taste of Lombard:

- NO YMCA PROGRAM T-SHIRTS OR VESTS WHEN WORKING THE BEER TENT
- Please wear *tennis shoes or work boots (no flip-flops, sandals, etc.)* while pouring and serving beer. (You need to be able to move quickly, and have a good sole on your shoe so you don't slip, or step on anything 'dangerous. We have found nails in the plywood in the past.) Plus, you really don't want all that beer spilling on your feet, do you?
- At least one member of your group needs to attend BASSET training.
- NO DRINKING alcohol while on the job. You need to be 100% clear-headed to serve the public.
- Please keep your non-alcoholic beverages behind the trailer while working. The Health Department mandates that we have none of our own cans, bottles. Etc. near the beer, which we are serving to the public. (It may spill into their drinks, then our germs get onto their cups. and disease is spread. and then possible chaos!)
- If you have a buddy working, you may not enjoy an alcoholic beverage with him/her while they are working. In other words. You must be in the public area to enjoy it. Do not hide behind the trailers to drink with your buddy while he/she is working.
- NO SMOKING while working. You must go to the public area in front of the tables from which you serve beer.
- Please bring the amount of adults specified on your contract. If you have less than what is specified, not only will you have a harder time. You may earn less money for your group per your contract.
- Please arrive 10 minutes before your shift begins to sign in and receive any specific instructions we may have for that day.
