Indian Guides! It's time to start getting ready for the 2nd annual

Winter Campout Rocket Race!

Saturday, February 9, 2008 at the Camp Matawa Lodge.

Weigh-in & start time approximately 1/2 hour after dinner.

Rocket Details:

- * Maximum length: 12 inches
- * Maximum width is 4 inches including fins
- * Maximum weight: 7 ounces

- An Average 2-liter pop bottle is the maximum dimensions
- The rocket glides down the string on its own weight
- NO propellant, fans, or anything that makes the rocket go faster or slower.
- Two hooks per rocket made from metal (no glass hooks) and no closer than 6 inches apart. Hooks must be open to hook onto the race string.
- No kits provided.... rockets can be created from kits purchased at a hobby shop, or materials from around the home, such as 2-liter pop bottles, tennis ball cans, pieces of wood, etc.... imagination and creativity are encouraged!

- * The boys will vote on the design/looks.
- * Awards for the winners of the race.

(The boys are encouraged to build as much of the rockets as they are capable of)

Injun Joe (Run by the Tribe Assigned)

Beginning on Saturday at 1 p.m. this event will begin. One Indian Guide will be assigned the responsibility of bringing an Injun Joe to the camp out. It must be soft and padded so as not to cause injury if it hits someone. The Guides may only handle Injun Joe. Injun Joe may not be hidden. Indian Guides may not lock or block their cabin doors to prevent Injun Joe from being put in their cabin.

Fire Pit

FIREWOOD WILL BE SUPPLIED THE CAMP

Bedding (Sleeping bag or equivalent) and pillow

Towels and toilet articles

Costumes at Dinner

Clothing for outing

N885 Youth Camp Road

Driving time is approximately 2 hours with no traffic and a short pit stop

Leave area via 294 North (Tri-State Tollway) towards Milwaukee

Tollway turns into 1-94/US-41 in Wisconsin

Just before Milwaukee (**exit 316 - ramp to the left**) take **1-43/I-894 bypass towards Madison/Fond du Lac**

Stay to the right and continue on 1-894/I-45 towards Fond u Lac. In 5 miles 1-43 will exit to the left (do not take 1-43).

At exit 1A the road changes into US-41/US-45. **Stay to the right heading toward Fond du Lac (I-41/I-45)**, not toward Madison

11 miles up the road, US-41 and US-45 split. Take **US-45 (right split) towards West Bend**

Follow **US-45 North** (18 miles) past West Bend and into Kewaskum

2 miles north of Kewaskum **turn right on Old Bridge Road. There is an electrical substation on the corner of County Road and US 45.**

One mile (**first stop sign**) **turn left onto County Road G.**

Two miles on County Road G to **Youth Camp Road and turn right.**
There is an informational **sign for the YMCA Camp (follow it).**

Camp Matawa entrance 1 mile on left. Camp sign on the road along with a YMCA Camp informational sign
