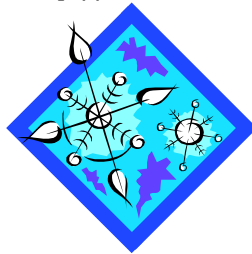

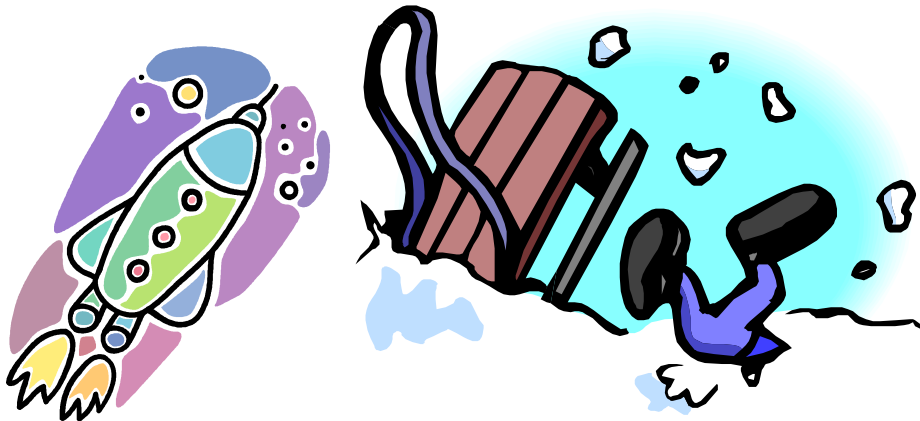

Directions from Chicago:

- Leave area via 294 North (Tri-State Tollway) towards Milwaukee
- Tollway turns into I-94/US-41 in Wisconsin
- Take exit 316 on the left to merge onto I-43 S/I-894 W toward Madison/Fond Du Lac
- Continue to follow I-894 W
- Continue onto US-45 N
- Turn left at Lannon Rd
- Take the 1st right onto Appleton Ave
- Turn left toward Amy Belle Rd
- Turn left at Amy Belle Rd
- Take the 1st right onto Bark Lake Rd
- Take the 2nd left onto Amy Belle Ln
- Destination will be on the right

Indian Guides! It's time to start getting ready for the annual
Winter Campout Rocket Race!

Saturday, January 30, 2010 at the Camp. Location to be determined
Weigh-in & start time approximately 1/2 hour after dinner.

Rocket Details:

- * Maximum length: 12 inches
- * Maximum width is 4 inches including fins
- * Maximum weight: 7 ounces
- An Average 2-liter pop bottle is the maximum dimensions
- The rocket glides down the string on its own weight
- NO propellants, fans, or anything that makes the rocket go faster or slower.
- Two hooks per rocket made from metal (no glass hooks) and no closer than 6 inches apart. Hooks must be open to hook onto the race string.
- No kits provided.... rockets can be created from kits purchased at a hobby shop, or materials from around the home, such as 2-liter pop bottles, tennis ball cans, pieces of wood, etc.... imagination and creativity are encouraged!
- * The boys will vote on the design/looks.
- * Awards for the winners of the race.

(The boys are encouraged to build as much of the rockets as they are capable. This is a fun event planed for our sons)
